

PruBSN Aspirasi Super Savings 2022 Campaign

Terms and Conditions

1. This Campaign is offered by Prudential BSN Takaful Berhad ("PruBSN"). By participating in this Campaign, you are bound by these terms and conditions.
2. Campaign Period: 1 October 2022 to 31 October 2022, both dates inclusive.
3. The Eligible Customer must provide accurate full name, identification number (NRIC), email, contact/mobile number and mailing address in the proposal form or in PruBSN Touch by 31 December 2022.
4. Campaign Eligibility:
 - a. Customer who participates in a new certificate (New Business) of **PruBSN Aspirasi** which fulfils the requirements mentioned in the table below and submits the proposal form to PruBSN from 1 October 2022 to 31 October 2022 (both dates inclusive), whereby such certificate must be approved and issued by 15 November 2022 ("Eligible Customer").
 - b. The certificates must continue to be in-force and all contribution payments are up to date as at 31 December 2022.
 - c. The **payment method** must be made via:
 - **Credit/Debit Card with subsequent e-enrolment via PruBSN Mobility or PruBSN Touch, or**
 - **Direct Debit with subsequent e-enrolment via PruBSN Mobility or PruBSN Touch**The required payment method above must be updated by 31 December 2022 and it is required to maintain the e-enrolment throughout the campaign reward duration.

5. Campaign Gift:

Each Eligible Customer who meets the Campaign Eligibility requirements stated in Paragraph 4, is entitled to **BSN Sijil Simpanan Premium (SSP)** with an amount stated below ("Gift") based on the requirements as per the table below:

6. BSN SSP is a type of deposit and a unique savings product by Bank Simpanan Nasional (BSN) since 1978. BSN SSP is a Shariah compliant product and guaranteed by the Government. For further details on BSN SSP, you may refer to BSN corporate website at www.mybsn.com.my
7. Eligible Customers who are entitled to the Gift will be notified via SMS sent to the certificate owner's mobile number stated in the proposal form or PruBSN Touch.
8. The BSN SSP Gift will be distributed to the Eligible Customers from 28 February 2023 onwards via courier or servicing agents.
9. Eligible Customers shall comply with all applicable anti-bribery and anti-corruption laws, including US Foreign Corrupt Practices Act, UK Bribery Act, Hong Kong Prevention of Bribery Ordinance, Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission Act 2009, and any related regulations and guidance thereto. PruBSN shall have the right to disqualify your entry/entries without notice in the event of any non-compliance or violation of the law in relation to your participation in this Campaign.
10. This Campaign excludes Agents' own certificate (where agent is a participant/ certificate owner in the plan) from this campaign.
11. All rights, interests, titles and benefits to the Gift are deemed to have passed to the Eligible Customer upon hand over of the Gift. In the event that the Gift is stolen or lost for any reason or under any circumstances, no replacement will be provided by PruBSN.
12. PruBSN may replace the Gift with another item of similar value without giving prior notice.
13. The Gift is not transferrable, not exchangeable and not redeemable for cash, credit or in kind.
14. The Gift provided is not intended as a variation to the terms and conditions of the takaful certificates received, which are subject to PruBSN's standard processing or underwriting rules.
15. PruBSN's decision on the Gift awarded is final, conclusive and bound by the terms and conditions stated above and no appeal will be entertained.
16. The terms and conditions are available in English and Bahasa Malaysia version. If there is any inconsistency, the English version shall prevail.
17. The terms and conditions shall be governed by the laws of Malaysia and subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of Malaysia.
